
# Why should we read the Bible / study the Bible?

- The Bible tells us how one truly gets to heaven, and it is not by being good or by being baptized or by anything else we do
   (John 14:6; Ephesians 2:1-10; Romans 3:10-18, 5:8, 6:23, 10:9-13)
- The Bible equips us to serve God (<u>2 Timothy 3:17</u>; <u>Ephesians 6:17</u>; <u>Hebrews 4:12</u>). It helps us know how to be saved from our sin and its ultimate consequence (<u>2 Timothy 3:15</u>)

Founded in 753 BC, Rome was the capital and head quarters of the Roman Empire. At the time of the Apostle Paul, it was the greatest city in the world.Most historians say that in the 1st century BC, Rome would have little more than 1 million inhabitants. To this day it is the most populous city in Italy.

# **Date and Location of Composition**

Paul wrote the letter to the Romans from the city of Corinth, while he was on his third missionary journey . At the time he was gathering an offering from the Gentile Christians for the church in Jerusalem (<u>Acts</u> <u>24:17</u>). This would place the letter's composition date at AD 56.


