First Principle: PRAYER

Recognition

- God is God
- We lack his mercy
- We are ALL sinners before God (Romans 3:23)

for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 3:23





<u>Intimacy</u>

- Have intimacy with God under any circumstance
- We were created to live in permanent communion with the Lord

O God, you are my God; early will I make my search for you: my soul is dry for need of you, my flesh is wasted with desire for you, as a dry and burning land where no water is;

Psalms 63:2





Sanctification

- Our sins prevent us from praying
- David asked God to probe his heart

O God, let the secrets of my heart be uncovered, and let my wandering thoughts be tested:

See if there is any way of sorrow in me, and be my guide in the eternal way.

Psalms 139:23,24





Humility

- The disposition to serve God has diminished
- Prayer = "gonypeteó" = kneel before God

But Simon, when he saw it, went down at the knees of Jesus and said, Go away from me, O Lord, for I am a sinner.

Luke 5:8

So that at the name of Jesus every knee may be bent, of those in heaven and those on earth and those in the underworld,

Philippians 2:10





Faith

Small word, great challenge
